Tractor boost for Graham

THE GARDENING business of disabled man Graham Henderson continues to flourish and yesterday he took delivery of new machinery which will enable him to tackle landscaping and ground maintenance projects all year round.

Graham, who was born with cerebral palsy, has gone from strength to strength over the last 13 years with Graham's Garden Care.

His new specially-adapted tractor, a New Holland TC27 complete with hydrostatic gearbox, was delivered yesterday by Hugh Ramsay of Edinburgh firm Russell Ground Care Equipment Ltd.

The purchase was facilitated by the Government's Placing, Assessment and Counselling Team (PACT).

Indeed Graham's business has been so successful that it is now used by the Prince's Scottish Youth Business Trust (PSYBT) as a model for young Scottish entrepreneurs. The PSYBT assisted Graham at start-up and with business development.

Graham is currently on the look out for additional storage facilities.
