A MONTROSE man behind a successful gardening business has been presented with an accolade of achievement by TV presenter Carole Baxter of the Beechgrove Garden.

On the eve of its 15 year celebrations, the Prince's Scottish Youth Business Trust, which helps people aged 18 to 25 to set up and continue in business, has recognised one of its first clients, Montrose-based Graham Henderson.

He set up his business, Graham's Garden Care, in 1989 with its support.

It was also a bit of a reunion for Graham (35) and Carole, who met for the first time 15 years ago when she presented him with a ScotVec qualification in gardening at a National Trust of Scotland Awards ceremony.

"It was a delight to see Graham again and to be able to hand over this award to him," said Carole.

"It is so important to recognise such an achievement. Graham's love of horticulture and positive attitude are to be commended and I hope others will follow his fine example."

Graham, a cerebral palsy sufferer, has maintained his business through peaks and troughs, diversifying from general grass cutting contracts in the summer to snow clearing car parks for major supermarkets in the winter.
